3-Man Speedball Tournament Rules

- 1. 3-Man format will be a 1 flag format with the flag placed in the center of the field.
- 2. The Objective is to be the first team to successfully capture the flag and carry it to the opposing teams' start base.
- 3. Time Each game will have a 5-minute time limit.
- 4. Points -Teams can receive points multiple ways. There is a maximum of 50 points a team can score each game. 25 points for the first team that successfully carries the flag to the opponent's base. 10 points for successfully pulling the flag. 5 points for each eliminated player on the opposing team.
- Markers Players may use either mechanical or electronic markers. Electronic markers must be capped at 7.5 balls per second and must be shot in semi-automatic mode. Markers must chrono in at 300fps or less.
- 6. Referees are chosen by the field operators and have final say on all issues. Referees will tally the score of each game and communicate scoring to the field operators for display.
- 7. Penalties will be assessed as needed if players don't leave the field after being eliminated. This will be a judgement call based on location of the hit, timing of the hit, and the consequences of staying in the game. Referees will confer and a decision will be made at the conclusion of the game.
- 8. Team rosters can be from 3-5 players and each player can only be on a single roster.
- 9. Games start and end on the whistle and will be restarted if anyone leaves the starting area prior to the whistle. More than one restart may result in penalties being assessed. Games end with either time-limit or maximum points being scored by a team.
- 10. Preliminary rounds of the tournament will be round-robin format with each team player at least 5 games. The points scored in these rounds will be used to determine the top 4 teams and those teams will be seeded accordingly in the Semi-Finals.
- 11. Semi-Finals will be the best-of-three format with the losing teams facing off for third place in a single game and the winners facing off in the Finals in a best-of-three format.
- 12. Have fun and let good sportsmanship rule the day!
